## A Fight for Food Equity

### Details:

- Pick the dish served at your restaurant that you are most proud of or the one you deem your best.
- Choose a restaurant who is either your biggest competition or one that you admire to challenge to a food fight!
- We will approach the restaurant you are challenging and gauge their interest. Once they agree, you will publicly (via social media) challenge them to a food fight, which they will accept.
- You are asked to bring at least 200 sample sized portions of this dish for the guests to try during the first hour and a half of the evening. They will vote for their favorite, and the winner will be declared the "Best Bite of the Night" Champion at the close of the evening.
- You will also bring five samples for the judges to taste. This will be a blind tasting. The judges will not know who made which dish when they are served. The judges will each choose their favorite of the two and the dish with the most nods from the judges will win the fight.
- Each restaurant or chef has the option to donate an experience (a dinner for four at their restaurant or cooking for a group of four people at the winner's home) for us to auction off during the event.
- This event will offer lots of publicity for the participating restaurants.
